

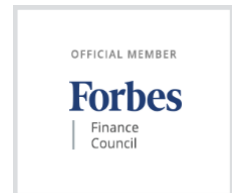
IBS Investment Bank Team to Attend the Association For Corporate Growth 2020 Fall Summit
